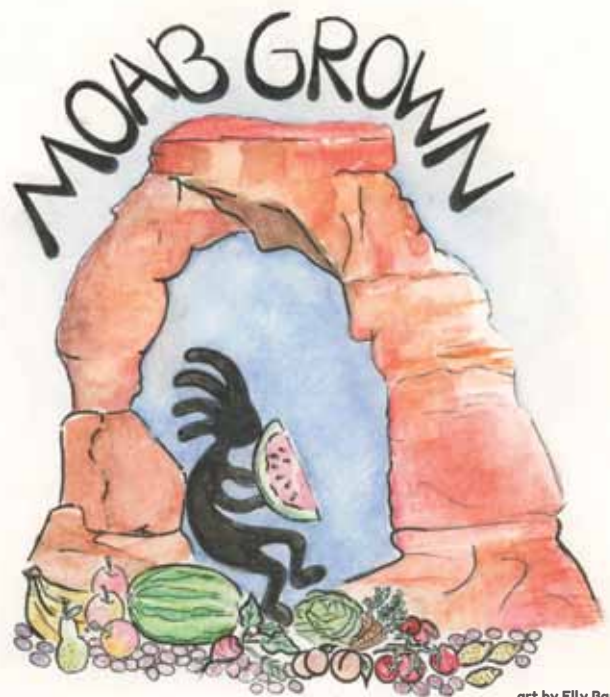

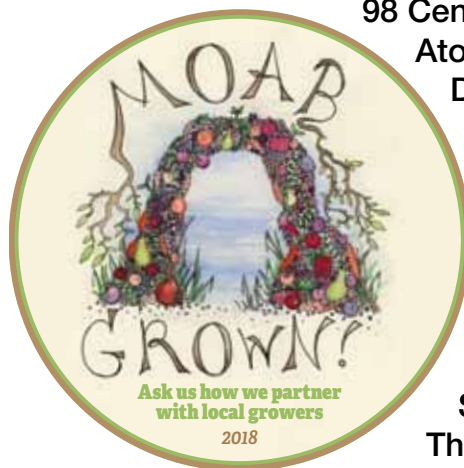

The 'Moab Grown' logo means the local restaurant has committed to partnering with local producers. Each restaurant must renew their commitment annually to facilitate business relationships between local farmers, ranchers and producers, meeting criteria set forth by Utah State University's Extension Sustainability program.
