Road Construction in Arches National Park

Roads close Sunday through Thursday nights at 7 pm through Nov. 30, 2017. Last entrance is 6:30 pm and you must be out of the park by 7 pm on those nights. Roads reopen at 7 am. The campground is closed through November 30.

Courthouse Towers and Park Avenue parking areas, viewpoints, and trails are closed for construction through mid-October. These areas are closed to all entry. You may not hike into these areas. Balanced Rock and La Sal Mountain Viewpoint are also scheduled to reopen mid-October.

SR 128 Road Work

Daytime road work continues. Work hours are from 7am-7pm. Travelers during these hours will encounter construction work with traffic limited to a single lane with up to fifteen minute delays in the work zone.
