Each month a special guest artist is invited to display their work, bringing a new perspective and a fresh look to the gallery. Step into Gallery Moab to see what magic our remarkable landscape can inspire!

Rebekka Anderson, a printmaker from Teasdale, Utah is the featured Guest Artist for November. She has been drawn to nature and wild places since she was young, which inspired her to follow a career path as a National Park Service Ranger. She spent nearly 20 years working in numerous western parks, including Zion, Sequoia, Yosemite, Grand Canyon, and



Anderson says the art of printmaking found her in 2018 when she first made Christmas cards for friends and family. The process of carving away what doesn’t belong, working in reverse, different methods of overlaying color, the bold lines created from sharp gauges, deep saturated colors, and gentle gradients continue to fascinate and inspire her creativity in the medium. She likens it to making the perfect cup of coffee, where all the separate factors catalyze to create the finished product. With coffee, the bean, the roast, the grind, the water temperature and pressure, and added sugars or milk come together with endless flavors. With printmaking, the paper thickness and
