Resilience in the face of adversity:
 A Moab Prison Camp: Japanese American Incarceration in Grand County unpacks the nuanced terminology inviting visitors to confront the usage of words like "relocation" versus "incarceration" and wrestle with the gravity of terms such as "concentration camp." Exhibition on display February - June 29, 2024.

The War Relocation Authority (WRA) established Citizen Isolation Centers to isolate alleged "troublemakers" from the larger incarceration camps. After being built as a Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) camp, the Dalton Wells facility was re-purposed to become the Moab Isolation Center.
