Our main goal is to reduce and prevent the incidence of child abuse by providing 24-hour Crisis Respite Care, and strength-based family education programs.

Community Rebuilds' Haunted Bunkhouse!

Community Rebuilds presents our first annual Haunted Bunkhouse on October 30th from 4pm-9pm at Community Rebuilds' Campus (150 S 200 E), which you can enter through the Mill Creek Bike Pathway. The event festivities include a fully spooked out haunted house in our two-story straw bale bunkhouse, kids crafts and activities, ghost stories around a 'fire', a costume contest decked out with a cemetery runway and costume booth, music, a dance party, lots of delicious and creepy treats, and all-around eerie vibes. This event is community powered; we have numerous nonprofits, artists, community members, and Halloween fanatics volunteering and helping to plan this exciting evening. Moab has not seen a haunted house in many years, and we are hoping to fill this gap for years to come. Admission to the whole event is \$15 for ages 12+, and \$5 for youth under 12. This admission gives you access to all the activities including the haunted house.

It would be impossible for Community Rebuilds to cover its expenses and maintain an affordable ticket price without the support of volunteers, a small, dedicated staff, and business sponsorships. Without this support, we would not be able to create a long-lasting community event.
