The gates will open at 4 pm on Friday, September 17th. Please bring your chair and join us for The Tattoo, which is a sample of the awesome entertainment you will get to experience on the weekend. Massed Bands will start off the evening followed by special music by Tom



Lambie, Comedy by Patrick Regan, music by The Lougheed Band, Traditional Irish Dance performed by The Rinceoiri Don Spraci Irish Dancers and ending the evening with wild tribal Celtic music by The Wicked Tinkers!

The Utah Heavy Athletics will sponsor a Strongman competition Friday 4-7:30 pm. This is a first for Moab and we are so excited for this event!

The Festivities will continue on Saturday, September 18th at 8 am. NEW THIS YEAR, if all goes as planned, we will have a parade at 11am. We will start at Main Street and proceed east on Center Street to the Ball Fields,

followed by the Opening Ceremony. The Pipes & Drum bands will join together on the field followed by the Clan March. Please stay and enjoy the traditional Scottish activities such as heavy athletics, featuring the Stone Put Championship, Highland dancing, Bagpipe band and solo competitions, clan booths, Whiskey tasting, door prizes, silent auction, vendors (both food and wares), and much more.

Saturday evening at 6 pm we will hold a Ceilidh, a traditional Scottish social gathering with another opportunity to enjoy the entertainment.

The competitions will continue on Sunday at 8 am. Please join us on the MVI Stage at 11 am for the Kirkin of the Tartan (a non-denominational religious service). At 2 pm we will hold the Closing Ceremony when the Awards will be presented.

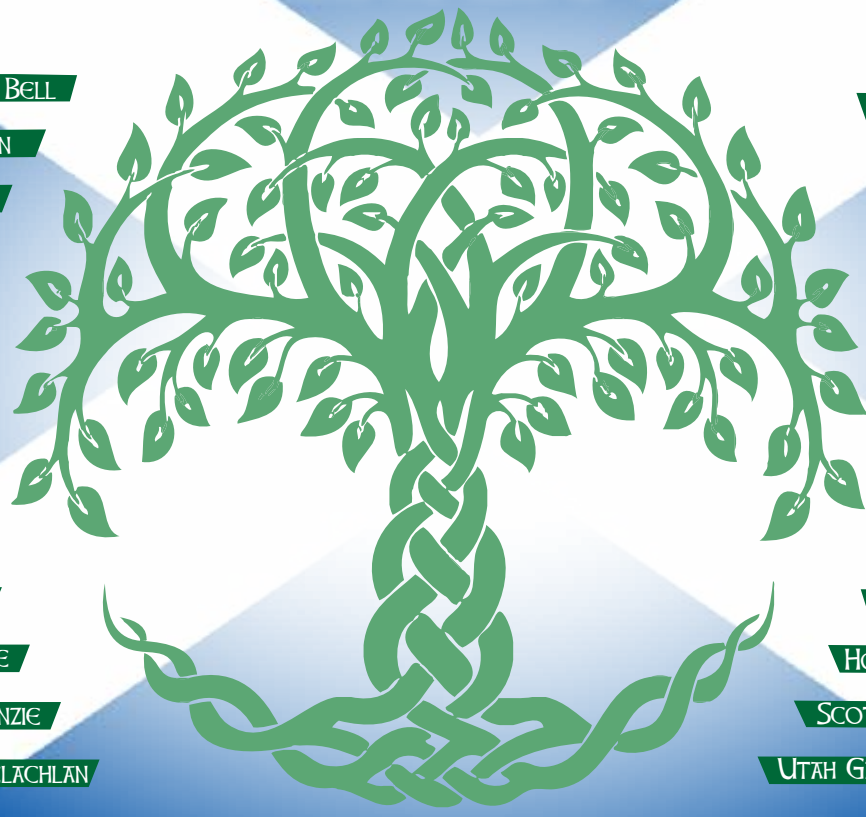
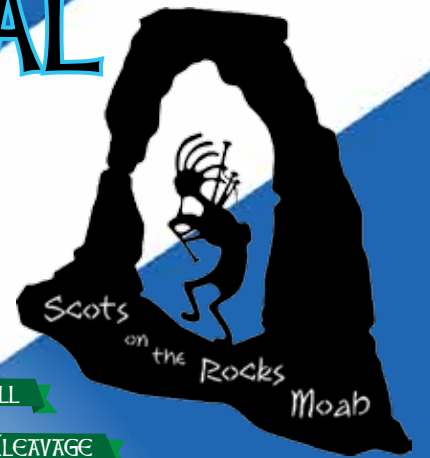
