About 25 volunteer DJs per week recorded and produced their shows from home during the months of March, April, May and June. That's more than 300 shows, lovingly and painstakingly created for you, dear listener, by our outstanding DJs; recorded at kitchen tables, back patios, bedroom closets, kitchens, and newly arranged home offices. The shows were transmissions from the hearts and homes of the community of Moab and the family of
